## Log/Pin SHOOT

### The Match

There are two match classifications for this event; Centerfire handgun CH (up to and including .500 SW) and Rimfire rifle RR (.22LR, .22MAG, .17HMR). There will be four stages in each classification and a 15 second limit for each stage. At the end of the 15 second mark all shooters are to stop shooting. Score is based on accuracy and number of bullets fired.

### Starting point and Stages

Stage 1 for the CH will be from the 7 yard line. Stage 1 for the RR will be from the 10 yard line. Stage 2 - CH 10 yard line, RR 13 yard line. Stage 3 - CH 13 yard line, RR 15 yard line. Stage 4 - CH 15 yard line, RR 18 yard line. Loaded firearms (6rnds) and ammunition will have already been staged at each shooting position. Once at the appropriate stage, the whistle will be blown to begin. From the low ready position the shooter will start engaging the targets until complete or until the allotted time has expired. Then score will be recorded and the following stages will be completed.

### Targets and Scoring

For each piece of wood knocked over and remaining on the table the shooter receives 1 point. For each piece of wood knocked off the table the shooter receives 2 points. If there are no pieces of wood left in the upright position, the shooter will receive 2 points for each bullet not fired. All of the shooter's stage scores are added together to reach the total match score. The highest match score win the match.

### Firearms

Handguns may be any type of center fire semi-automatic pistol or revolver. Rifles may be any type of rim fire semi-auto, pump, or lever action. Any type of optic or sight may be used on either class.

### Ammunition

Ammunition may be lead, semi-jacketed, or full jacketed. There is a restriction of twelve bullets per stage, six in the firearm and six additional. The additional ammunition will be staged at the firing position. Only one spare magazine/speed loader, with six rounds, is allowed. Match ammo count: *Centerfire handgun - 48 rounds, Rimfire rifle - 48 rounds.*

### Rules and Regulations

Any unsafe handling of a firearm both on and off the firing line is means for disqualification. Accidental Discharges will result in DISQUALIFICATION. Eye and ear protection will be worn by shooters, RSOs, and spectators when there are people on the firing line. All firearms will be pointed down range and will not be loaded until directed to do so by RSO at the staging tables. Reloading can be performed as needed.

Treat all firearms as if they are loaded  
Never let the muzzle cover anything you are not willing to destroy  
Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot  
Be sure of your target and beyond
